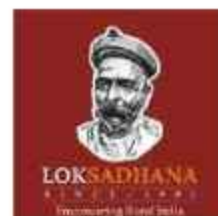

About Us

Lokmanya Public Charitable Trust, also known as Loksadhana, was founded in 1982 by Dr. Raja Dandekar and Prof. Renu Dandekar in Chikhalgaon, the birthplace of Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak. Since then, Loksadhana has been dedicated to serving Chikhalgaon and 56 surrounding villages, impacting a community of over 60,000 people. Our primary areas of focus include Education, Health, Skill Development, Agriculture, Women Empowerment, and Rural Development. We have successfully executed more than 80 developmental projects, driven by our mission to create rural solutions for rural problems.

Education is the catalyst for social change, and we continuously strive to meet the community's educational needs. Our educational initiatives include a Primary School, Secondary School, and Higher Secondary School, all strongly supported by our Skill-Based Education wing. We are equipped to provide housing for 100 underprivileged boys and 100 underprivileged girls through our hostel facilities.

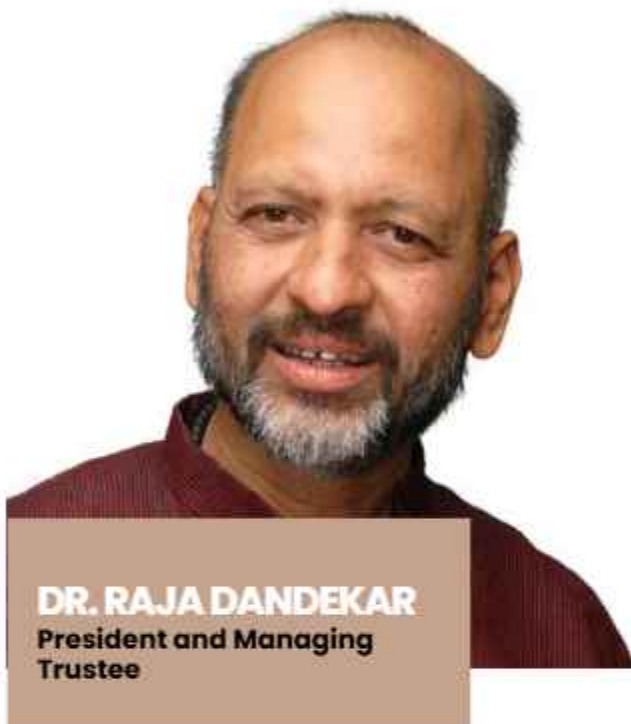
Our skilling vertical includes the Multi Skill Technical Assistant curriculum, focused on imparting business-ready skills to children from 5th standard to 10th standard. We also offer a Diploma in Basic Rural Technology, which trains rural youth with vocational skills, and a Patient Assistant Program, a course that trains rural girls to become caregivers.

In addition to education, we engage deeply with the community through projects like LokBAG, which focuses on recycling textile waste, and various community-level surveys. VidyaVahan - The Joyful Ride

This year, our school received a brand-new school bus thanks to the CSR contribution from **Finolex Plasson Industries Private Limited, Pune**. Many students at Loksadhana School still walk four to five kilometers from their homes to the bus stop. Often, they miss school because they can't find transportation. To overcome these challenges, VidyaVahan is now ready. This bus will enable 40 children from remote areas to attend school every day, reducing their commuting difficulties. Loksadhana is deeply grateful to Finolex Plasson Industries Private Limited, Pune. For many years, this company has been a steadfast partner in our rural development initiatives.

A Revamped School

The benches in six classrooms of Loksadhana School had become quite old. Despite multiple repairs by our skill development department, they were no longer suitable for use. To procure new benches, Loksadhana made an appeal, and **Hon'ble Mr. Shrikant Sahasrabuddhe** generously stepped in to turn our dream into reality. With his donation, Loksadhana Secondary School received 120 new benches, and the Primary School received 40 new benches. The transformation of the classrooms was remarkable. Comfort and Warmth

Loksadhana operates two hostels, accommodating 100 boys and 100 girls. These hostels provide shelter and meals for economically disadvantaged and marginalised rural children. These children, coming from extremely challenging backgrounds, need warmth and care. We all wanted to ensure they had access to hot water, leading to the initiation of Project LokUrja.

Through the CSR contribution of **Veritas Software Technologies India Private Limited, Pune**, Loksadhana has installed solar and boiler hot water systems for the Shivrimal Boys' Hostel and the Leelavati Girls' Hostel. Now, all children residing in these hostels have access to hot water 24/7. We are confident that Veritas Software Technologies India Private Limited, Pune, will continue to support us in implementing projects that complement education. Loknirman 5 – A Festival of Creative Young Minds

Typically, we receive around 400 to 500 applications, from which 150 young men and women are selected through interviews. These vibrant young minds become part of the residential camp in Chikhalgaon for ten days.

This year, the Deep Dive session featured distinguished guests such as Mr. Aniket Amte (Lokbiradari Project), Mr. Siddhesh Sakore (Agro Rangers), Namita Bhawe, Mr. Advait Dandavate (Vardhishnu), Mr. Prasad Karambeikar (Tabla Artist), and Mr. Kshitij Date (Actor) and Hon'ble Gurushree. Shri. Shantanu Joshi (Prana Mission Foundation), who engaged in enlightening conversations with the participants. Youngsters aged 18 to 30 from all over Maharashtra, as well as from Delhi, Tamil Nadu, and Chhattisgarh, took part in the camp.

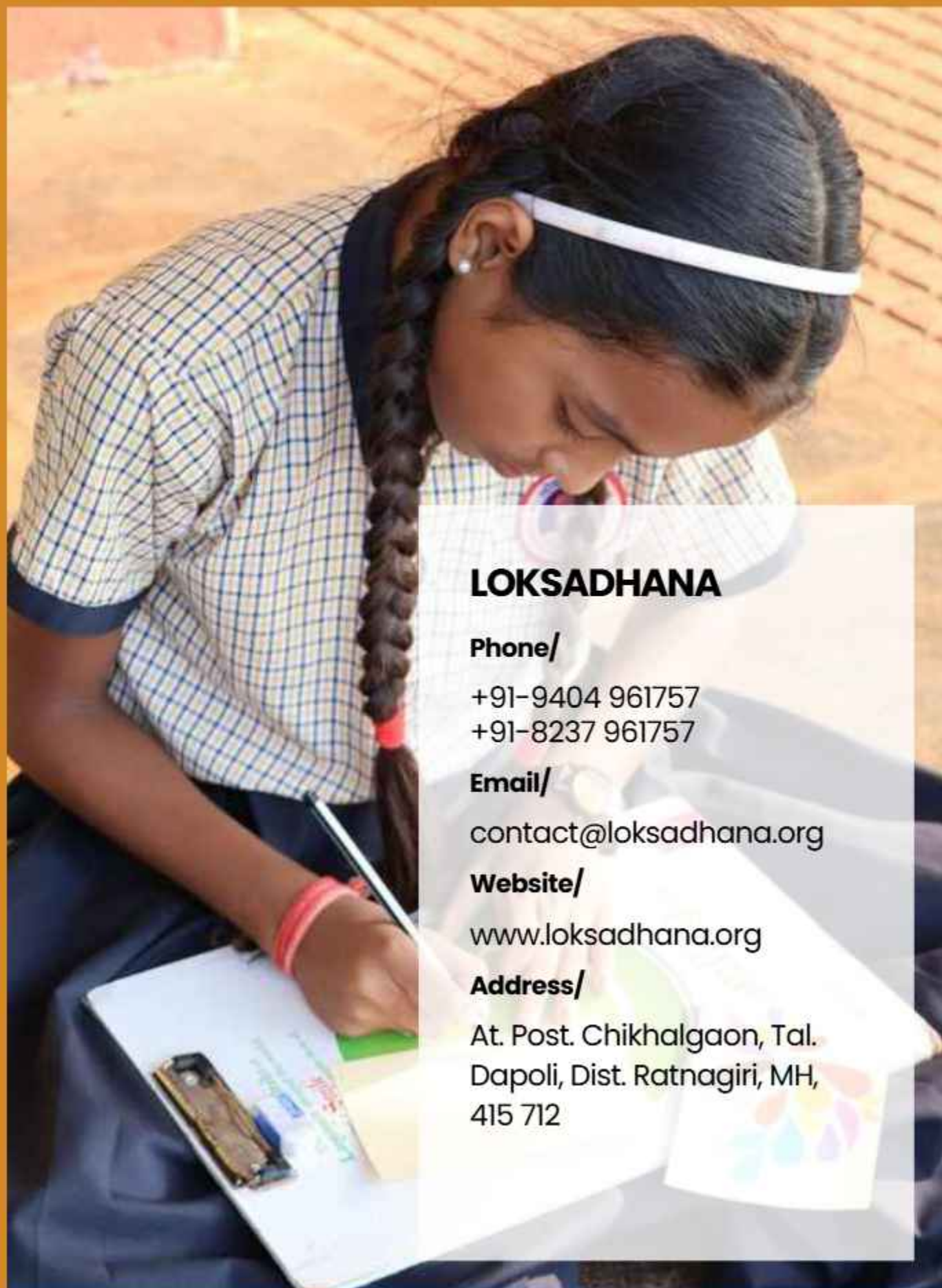
